This past year, the developers at Instructure gave the Canvas New Gradebook a good “tire kicking” before releasing it *en masse*. Most of the changes are subtle, but some of the changes are very powerful and very informative when you look a little deeper. Let’s briefly discuss some of the new advanced features that you may be excited to try.

Let’s Start with the Cool Stuff

The new Gradebook makes it possible to filter lists of student assignment groups by module, by section, and by student group.

New functionality also includes setting late policies and post policies, as well as deeper integration with Canvas analytics. Also, inserting zeros is handy by using the set default grades feature.

As always, the Instructure forums provide and active space for discussing changes to Canvas. You can also contact the CIRT if you need assistance, support, or training on any of these new Canvas features.

New Features

Updated Functions & Capabilities

Functionality	Legacy Gradebook	New Gradebook
Student sorting	Alphabetically by last name	First or last name, and/or secondary info
Arrange columns by...	Assignment group, due date, or points	Also, assignment name and modules
Filter columns by...	Section only	Also, assignments group and/or modules
Sort assignment grades by...	By grade only	Also, sort by missing and late grades
Icons and colors...	Info on assignments and submissions	Also, incomplete grades, GPA, and more

How do I ...

Access SpeedGrader	Click to enter a grade for an assignment and then select the Grade Detail Tray icon (on the right).
Provide comments	Click to enter grade for an assignment, then select the Grade Detail Tray icon (on the right).
Message students who...	Mouse over the name of an assignment and click on the three vertical dots.
Sort the totals column	Mouse over "Total" and click on the three vertical dots that come up and make desired change.
Set default grades	Mouse over the name of an assignment and click on the three vertical dots.
Import/export grades	The location of this option has moved to under the "Actions" link.
View Gradebook history	The location of this option has moved to under the "Gradebook" link.

TOP THREE NEW FEATURES

New Post Policies

New Gradebook has expanded the *Mute* feature for graded assignments into a *Posting Policy*. Posted grades are visible to students in your course and unposted grades are not. Best practice is to set the post policy for an assignment before entering any grades if grades need to be hidden.

Custom & Persistent Views

Instructors can create a custom filter to look at specific groups of assignments. There are options to filter by sections, modules, grading periods, and assignment groups. The filters can be layered and are persistent after the Gradebook has been closed.

Sort-by Options

Another new feature is the ability to sort individual assignments by missing or late status and grade value. In conjunction with this feature, teachers also commonly use messaging options, which was also available in the legacy version of the Gradebook, to easily communicate with students based on their submission status.
